Update on In-Person Worship and Gatherings from Pastor Janet

I have been part of numerous zoom meetings with the Synod. The Synod has been in touch with the MDH and the CDC. As May 4 approaches, in-person worship and gatherings will be considered according to the following without specific dates as yet: * First, in-person worship and small gatherings (10 or less) which does not include vulnerable (over age 60) individuals present may be held.

Second, in-person worship and small gatherings (20 or less) which does not include vulnerable (over age 60) individuals present may be held.

* Third, in-person worship and small gatherings (50 or less) which does not include vulnerable (over age 60) individuals present may be held.

* Parking lot services where people remain in their cars may be permitted at a later date. No Outdoor services are to be held at this time.

So this will put us, both Melo and OSL, out to the middle or end of May at the earliest. Next Tuesday, May 5, we will have a more firm update.

We will continue on-line services and all virtual ministries at this time.

The church councils will be making the final decisions as things open up.

New Business:

Pastor Janet is also looking into alternative worship formats with a shorter length. She has been very active in the community through video and phone calls.

Upcoming Worship: We will take a Sabbath from communion for the time being. Holy Week Worship will be done by the NW Minnesota Synod Bishop and uploaded onto our website.

Confirmation: Packets will be sent in May for youth to continue their confirmation studies from home. Communion classes are postponed until the fall. Bible studies are cancelled until further notice. Synod assembly is cancelled.

We are exploring grants who offer some additional funding during the pandemic.

A time and talents interest survey will be considered in the fall.

The next council meeting will be held on April 21.
