Senior Ladies Shorts for #2 Uniform, year round

- must be close to knee length
- must be traditional navy colour
- no side pockets ("cargo pant" style)
- no "super skinny" styles accepted, slim fit is acceptable
- no jeans, super stretch, or jegging material accepted

Khaki Pants for #2 Uniform, year-round

- must be ankle length or longer (not skimmer or capri length)
- must be traditional khaki colour, as per the designated styles
- no side pockets ("cargo pant" style)
- no "super skinny" styles accepted, slim fit is acceptable
- no jeans, super stretch, or jegging material accepted

Makeup/Jewellery

The school recognizes an adolescent's choice in wearing make-up (including nail polish) and jewellery. Makeup and nail polish must be subtle, natural in appearance and well-maintained. Students may wear a nose piercing so long as it is a colorless, small stud (less than 2.5mm) and parental permission is granted. We understand that many of our girls, and occasionally boys, have pierced ears, we would ask that parents ensure earrings are small and conservative. Large, dangling earrings are not appropriate for school. Please note that facial piercings, other than nose studs, and visible tattoos are not permitted. All final decisions concerning uniform requirements and personal appearance will be made by the Director of Senior School and/or Head of School.
