OVERVIEW

Disasters, such as Hurricane Irma, can have devastating impacts on a community's economic, social, and environmental well-being. There are several programs funded by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to help communities recover from such disasters and mitigate future disaster damage. In Florida, these programs are administered through the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM).

Recovery starts with reimbursements for direct losses and recovery efforts. But since disasters can be repeat events, it's especially important that communities consider smart ways to rebuild and provide long-term mitigation strategies to avoid future disaster damage. FEMA public assistance programs can also be a funding source for mitigation activity associated with disaster damage or reducing risk of future damage.

The seminar is focused on local governments and how communities can play a key role in recovery by understanding FEMA's programs and how to reduce risk by applying an understanding of local hazards to risk reduction planning. These efforts are most effective when implemented consistently with risk reduction priorities identified at the community level.

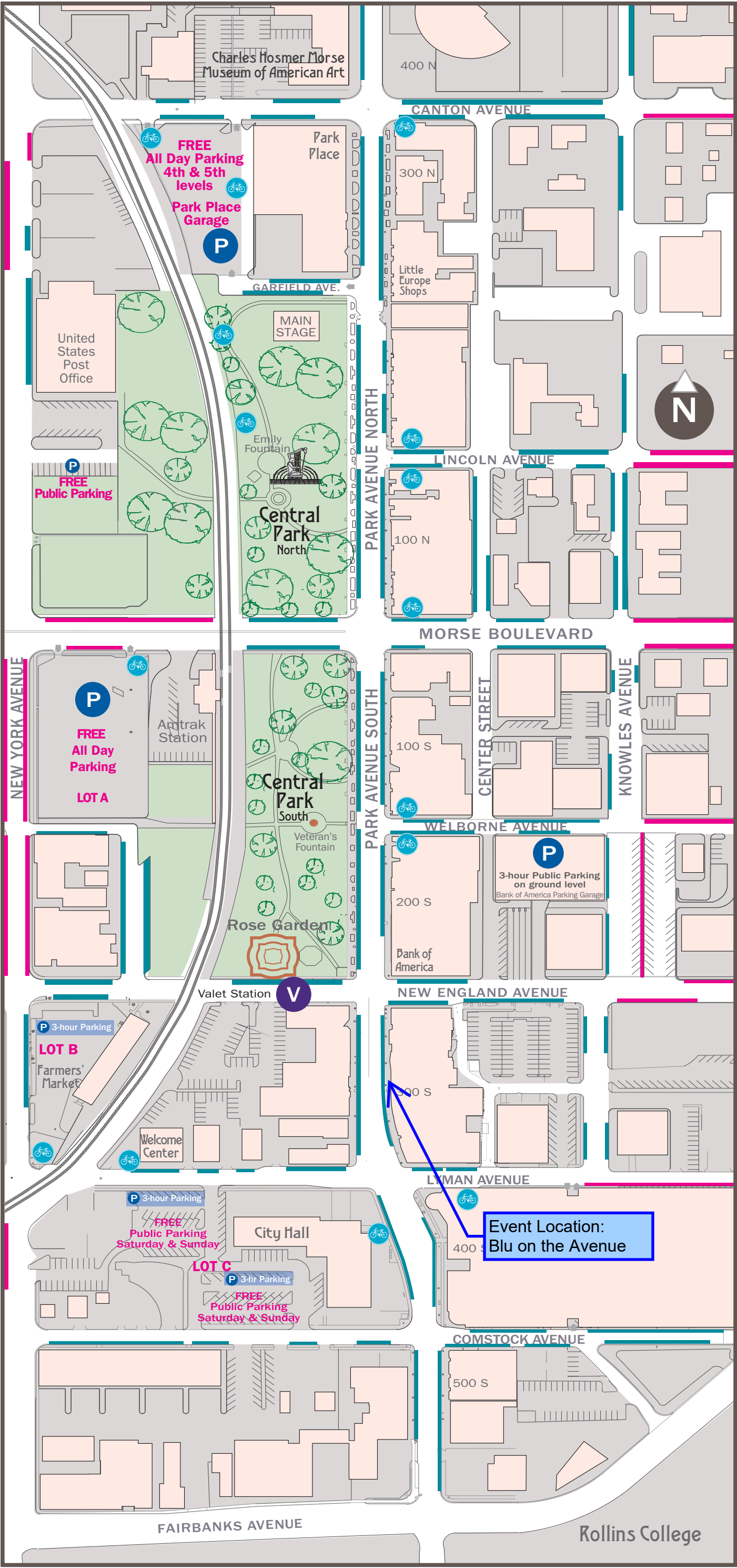

Welcome to Downtown

Whether you are a first-time visitor or a local resident who enjoys everything downtown has to offer, we want to make the downtown experience even better. This guide will help you locate where to park in downtown Winter Park, along with other tips and information.

Please note that this map only designates lots and garages open to the general public and does NOT include parking that is exclusive to a specific establishment or leased monthly.

- FREE 3-hour parking is available along Park Avenue and the side streets.
- FREE 4-hour parking is available along New York Avenue & two blocks in on the side streets.
- FREE 3-hour parking is available on the ground level of the Bank of America Garage.
- FREE 4-hour parking is available in Lot B.
- FREE all day parking is available in Lot A.
- FREE all-day parking is available on levels 4 & 5 in the Park Place Garage.
- FREE parking is available Saturday & Sunday in Lot C.
- FREE Valet Service Station is available on New England Avenue next to the railroad tracks.

The city also strives to promote safe and secure bicycle parking to complement our growing bicycle community, as well as to enhance the city's Pedestrian & Bicycle Circulation Plan. Please see the map for a detailed view of bike rack locations throughout the the Park Avenue district.

Assistance

If you need assistance while you are visiting downtown, remember to take advantage of the Winter Park Welcome Center, located at 151 West Lyman Avenue. Information is readily available regarding retail shops, restaurants, events and museums.
