It was the beginning of a new routine in these pre-summer days. At 6:08 a.m. our Black Labrador, Maddie, had her black harness around her for the first time in over a week. The significance of the harness rather than a collar for her means she and I will have a longer walk/jog around the neighborhood rather than just taking care of her business. With her new excitement in a new home in Wylie, she was ready to go.

Yes, 6:08 a.m. (or crack of dawn as Marlane would call it), we had our jogging gear on and head out the door, down one flight of stairs, and bust through the door to the outside of the apartment building, head on to the warm sultry air around us –

77 degrees and high humidity at 6:08 a.m. This was different though not in just temperature but a different landscape and different street noise and no canals (different smells for Maddie).

What a glorious time because we were out exercising together and in a new environment, and I was getting my cardio workout with something other than boxes and stair climbing.

Our walk/jog (Maddie's fast walking) led us on a 2.5 mile out and back trip along McCreary Road and Highway 544 in Wylie. Both of us were panting, sweating, and enjoying the time together. However, someone else joined us along the way. The Holy Spirit was right there with us as we moved along, conversed, and smiled at one another (I know that some of you think I'm crazy at this point). There was a glorious point in time, though, when I found myself singing aloud a song that the congregation of FUMC Irving will be singing this Sunday:

*Holy Spirit, You are welcome here
Come flood this place and fill the atmosphere
Your glory, God, is what our hearts long for
To be overcome by Your presence, Lord
Your presence, Lord*

I found myself overcome by the Spirit's presence with us in that moment (in fact, all moments). A few moments later Maddie and I had a visual affirmation of His presence as we rounded the apartment building toward home and looked out to the horizon and saw the breaking of the rising sun's rays from behind a thunderhead to the east. Yes, the Holy Spirit was very much present with us. And I might remind, very much present with all of us, all the time. Maybe the song's bridge is what needs to sing:

*Let us become more aware of Your presence
Let us experience the glory of Your goodness*

Prayer: *Holy Spirit, may I recognize you and welcome you into my life anew, moment by moment and day by day, experiencing your presence and goodness. Amen.*
