Jack's Journal



"O give thanks to the Lord for he is good; for His steadfast love endures forever." 1 Chronicles 16:34"

Yes, the stores display Halloween items, and our Walmart already has Christmas displays. It seems our society will pass by Thanksgiving except for a turkey dinner and a football game. So sad.

The challenge for me and possibly many of us, though, is to be thankful. To give thanks is very important for our wellbeing each and every day. God calls us to give thanks with a grateful heart for the big

things, the little things and the things in between.

Maybe we could begin to give thanks on a daily basis from today through Christmas, rather than limit it to one Turkey/Football day? Yet, I am in awe of some of you who are already thankful; in fact, you radiate thankfulness.

As I reflect back to this morning, I recall two instances (yes, I know there are many more) where I was called to be thankful. First, I prayed with a friend whose husband is in neuro-ICU and began with, "Thanks to you O God, for this beautiful, cool morning." And then I added additional thanksgivings for the family, hospital and staff, and friends who are caring with and for them, and for Jesus' healing.

Second, earlier this morning, Marlane told me about a Facebook post from our daughter, Meri, about an intimate moment with our granddaughter, Zoey. Marlane read it to me what Meri wrote:

Every night I sing the song Jesus Name Above All Names to Zoey before bedtime. After the first verse I use the same tune to sing a prayer for her, our 2q [Zoey's chromosome deletion] friend Madeline, Mya, Frankie, Papa, and then whomever else we need to pray for always in THAT order. Tonight, I prayed for Madeline first. Zoey pushed up into a sitting position and signed "Me" and "music". Hahaha! She knew that I was doing it out of order and told me to pray for her first.

After reading the post myself a few moments ago, I immediately gave thanks that Meri prays with Zoey. I gave thanks the Meri sings a song she learned as child in Kid's Praise that she can share with Zoey to give comfort and assurance of God's love. I gave thanks that Meri teaches Zoey to pray for others as Marlane and I taught Meri as a child. I gave thanks that God shows us again and again that Zoey understands, and even if she is not as verbal as we would hope at this point of her life, she is able to communicate visually to acknowledge her understanding.

So brothers and sisters, maybe we should not emphasize Halloween and whisk forward to Christmas, but enter into a life to *"GIVE THANKS to the Lord for He is good; for His steadfast love endures forever."* AMEN!
