

Election Schedule

- **Tuesday, October 24:** Informational meeting, applications available
- **Thursday, October 26:** 4th -8th grade applicants- Turn in your completed and signed applications to your classroom teacher/Mrs. Henzel for their recommendation. Teachers should complete the attached recommendation form and turn in to Mrs. Decker by Friday morning.
- **Friday, October 27:** Students who turned in completed applications attend a lunch meeting with Mrs. Decker about campaign procedures and rules, and will be informed of which offices they are eligible to run for at 12:35pm in Mrs. Decker's classroom (Room 311).
- **Monday, October 30-Monday, November 6:** Each candidate may display 3 posters in the hallways. They must be no larger than 16"x 20". They must be put up with scotch tape. NO PINS!!!! Candidates may pass out flyers or stickers to classmates asking for their votes. Candy, gum, money or anything used as a toy may NOT be given away.
- **Tuesday, October 31: Speeches-** We are trying something new!! All candidates will meet at lunch with the Cinematography Club to record their speeches. Speeches will be posted online and viewed by classes before election day.
- **Monday, November 6: ELECTION DAY!** Voting will be by class from 9:30-11:00am. After lunch, the ballots will be counted by the election committee.
- Results will be posted by 3:20pm that day. In case of a tie, a run off will take place on Wednesday, **November 8**
