## City Improvement Projects

### Aquatics Center

### Recreation Park Lighting Upgrade

The old lighting at the El Segundo Park Tennis Courts has been removed, and site preparation work has begun. The new lighting equipment is ready to be installed, and the project should be wrapped up by mid-April.

### Imperial Highway Resurfacing

Imperial Highway eastbound between Sepulveda and Aviation will soon be a smoother drive. The top layer of asphalt will be removed and replaced with a new layer of rubberized asphalt. Rubberized asphalt is a material made by blending ground-up recycled tires with asphalt, which is then mixed with conventional aggregate materials. Rubberized asphalt is more durable, safe, and quiet than traditional asphalt, and it is long lasting. It resists cracking, and it provides better skid resistance and traction.

California produces over 40 million waste (scrap) tires per year. The majority of waste tires end up in our landfills. However, a two-inch-thick rubberized asphalt resurfacing project uses about 2,000 waste tires per lane mile. The Imperial Highway Resurfacing project will *help divert between 7,000–8,000 waste tires from our landfills!* The project is slated to begin in late March, and it is expected to be completed by early May 2017.
