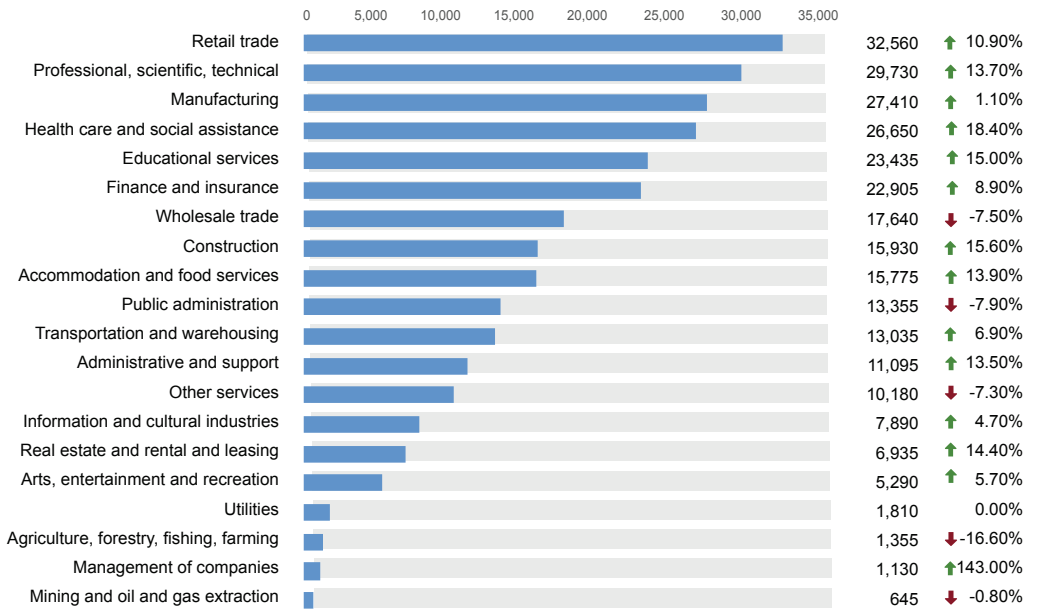

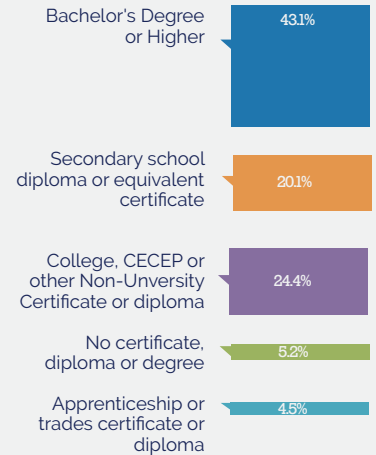

## Education of the Workforce



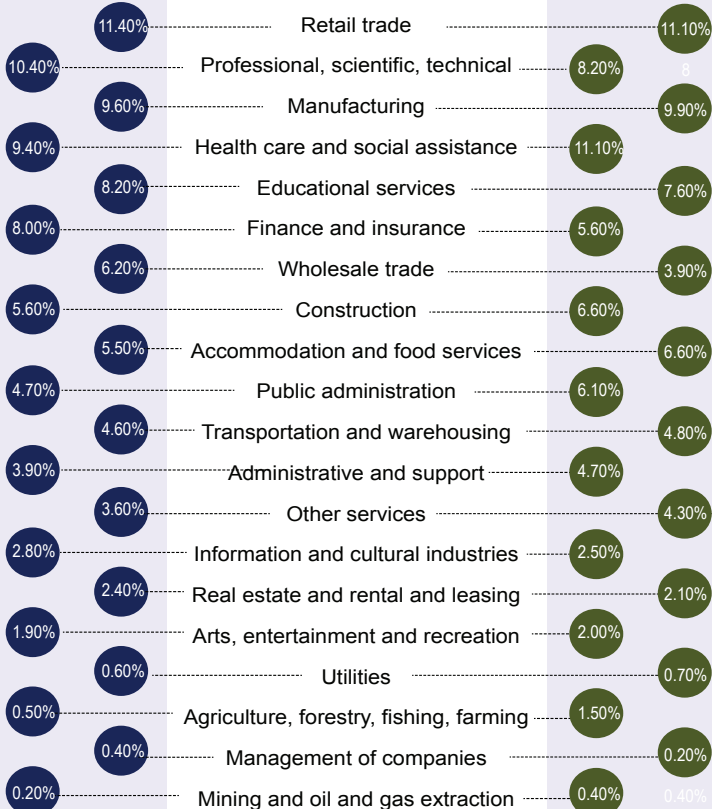
Percentage of the Halton population aged 25-64 years with selected highest levels of educational attainment

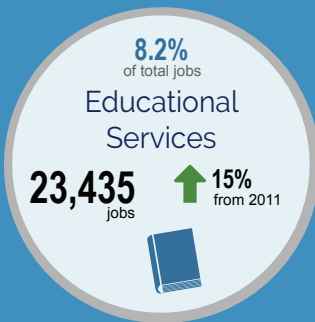

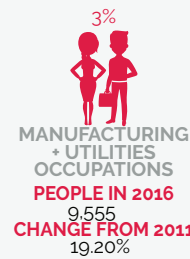
## Men and Women-Fields of Study

18.3% of women aged 25 to 64 with a bachelor's degree or higher studied STEM (science, technology, engineering and mathematics) and 81.7% studied BHASE (non-STEM) fields of study such as business, humanities, health, arts, social sciences, education, etc.

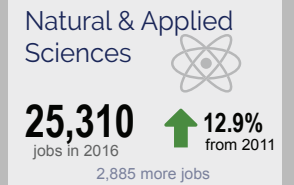
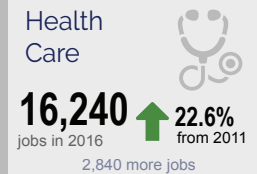
35.8% of men aged 25 to 64 with a bachelor's degree or higher studied STEM and 64.2% studied BHASE.



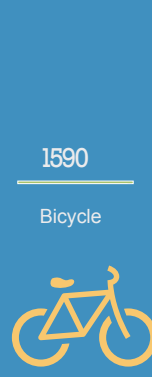
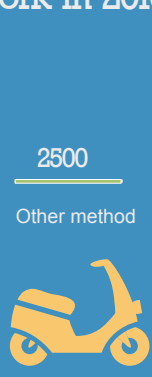
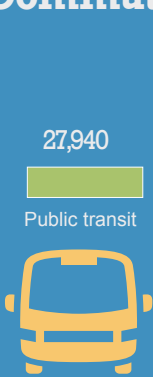
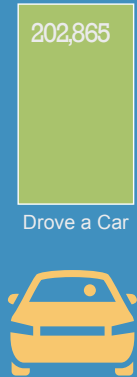
## 2016 EMPLOYMENT BY OCCUPATION IN HALTON
