How to Connect with the 2017 IFFM Convocation

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1. WHAT IS IFFM?

The International Fellowship of Faith Ministries (IFFM) is an international outreach for missions based in Faith Ministries Church of Columbus, Ohio. Since 2007, its goal has been to create an international network of mission minded churches, church leaders and church members which, through preaching, teaching and healing, will serve as a catalyst for the development of individuals, churches, communities and nations around the world. It currently has a presence in nearly 30 different nations.

2. WHAT USUALLY HAPPENS AT AN IFFM CONVOCATION?

Usually, the last week of July since 2007, the Annual IFFM Convocation has been a time of mission and church leadership oriented workshops and worship. IFFM leaders from around the world have come to Faith Ministries Church in Columbus, OH to be charged, challenged and changed. All of this has led to the edification of the local church and greater glory to God.

3. WHAT IS DIFFERENT ABOUT THIS YEAR'S CONVOCATION?

In addition to inviting delegates to Columbus, we are encouraging chapters, churches and friends to use their own homes, churches, businesses and chapters as a base for the Convocation. Common materials will be shared with registered groups which they can use in their own locations during the week of July 23-30, 2017. On Saturday, July 29, 2017, a morning of workshops and worship will be held live at Faith Ministries Church for those who are able to get to the church and broadcasted live over the internet at www.livestream.com/faithministrieschurch from 9 AM - 12 PM (EST).

4. WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THIS YEAR'S CONVOCATION?

To create an international, interdenominational and multicultural experience which will:

- Increase the awareness of and activity in the area of missions in general.
- Emphasize the possibility and responsibility of individual Christians and churches to do missions in their own area.
- Bring visibility to IFFM and its ministry around the world.
- Strengthen IFFM Chapters and the IFFM network worldwide.

5. WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE?

Sunday – Friday - July 23-28, 2017 – Groups meet on their own in their own localities throughout the world to watch the same video(s) and discuss the same written materials. As the groups are led and able, we ask them to consider receiving an offering for IFFM which they will forward to IFFM in Columbus, OH.

Saturday - July 29, 2017 from 9 AM to 12 PM (EST)

- Workshops with powerful speakers on the subject of how to do outreach in your area.
- Small groups in the greater Columbus area will gather for this session at Faith Ministries Church
- This session will be broadcast live via Internet worldwide with translation in French and Spanish
- FREE Lunch after the Columbus session

Sunday – July 30, 2017 at 10 AM

- Worship Celebration at Faith Ministries Church which will be broadcasted live via Internet at www.livestream.com/faithministrieschurch

6. DO I HAVE TO BELONG TO FAITH MINISTRIES CHURCH TO PARTICIPATE?

Absolutely not! This is open to everyone, no matter the church denomination or location in the world.

7. HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO PARTICIPATE?

There is no charge to participate in the Convocation abroad. A free will offering will be received at the group meetings to help defray the expenses. For those attending the Convocation in Columbus, there is a registration fee of \$25.00 (USD) per person.

8. WHAT IS THE REASON FOR THE OFFERING WHICH IS BEING ASKED?

This worldwide mission event is being offered for free to you, but it does cost us. This free will offering will help offset some of the expenses involved in preparing and distributing materials used, as well as, implementing this monumental, yet rewarding task.

9. HOW DO I BECOME A HOST OR GROUP LEADER?

A host is a person who provides the space for the meeting. The group leader is the person who conducts the meeting. This could be two people or one person fulfilling the two different functions. You can become a group leader or host by recruiting 5-15 people who are willing to spend one hour during the week of July 23-30, 2017 watching the Convocation Video. Then, by participating in the Saturday workshop in person at Faith Ministries, live via Internet or using suggested videos which will be provided. Set a date, place, time you are going to meet. Go online at www.IFFMUS.com website and click the link below the video invitation to register your group. Registration is free. The materials will be sent out to registered groups beginning July 10th. Other materials will be posted online at www.IFFMUS.com. Please contact the IFFM headquarters at (614) 416-8500 ext. 5 for the cost of getting materials outside of the US.

10. WHAT MATERIALS COME IN THE PACKET?

Upon registration, groups will receive the videos and information necessary to help them implement the program in their area, conduct the group meeting, and provide written resources for their own group members.

11. WHAT LANGUAGES WILL THE MATERIALS BE IN?

Most video materials will be provided in English with French or Spanish interpreters. Written materials will be offered in all three languages.

12. HOW AND WHEN CAN I PICK UP MY MATERIALS?

The materials will be available for pickup at Faith Ministries Church in Columbus, OH on Saturday, July 8th from 10 AM – 3 PM; Sunday, July 9th at 10 AM Worship; and Tuesday, July 10th from 6 PM – 8 PM. The week of July 10th, they will also be mailed to those groups who have registered prior to that and then immediately to those who register after July 10th. Some notes and other materials will be available to be downloaded for free from the internet at www.IFFMUS.com. **JUST TO MAKE SURE THAT EVERYONE CAN BE REACHED, THE VIDEOS FOR THE SMALL GROUP SESSION WILL BE POSTED IN ALL THREE LANGUAGES ON YOUTUBE.COM THE WEEK AFTER JULY 19TH.** Look for the links on the web site at www.IFFMUS.com.

13. WILL THERE BE ANY TRAINING FOR GROUP LEADERS?

There will be no live training for this session. However, you can find a video by Dr. Wise on how to lead a small group online at www.IFFMUS.com.

14. HOW DO I JOIN A GROUP?

The best way to join a group is to start one! You can do this by recruiting 5-15 people who are willing to spend about an hour during the week of July 23-30 watching the Convocation Video. And then, by participating at some level in the Saturday workshop. If you do not want to start a group, a list of registered groups will be posted on the website at www.IFFMUS.com after July 19 and you may choose to join a group which best suits you.

15. HOW CAN CHURCHES AND OTHER GROUPS GET INVOLVED?

To get involved, either the pastor or a member of the church (with the pastor's permission) can call together a special group or an existing group such as Weekday Bible study, small groups, a Sunday school class or families to be an official group. After someone accepts the responsibility to host and/or lead a group, he or she can register the group online at www.IFFMUS.com. One church can have as many groups of 5-15 people as it wants. The same goes for social groups, fraternities, sororities, shelters, prisons and on and on. You may also call (614) 416-8500 exr. 5 to request assistance if you feel the need for it.

16. WHAT DO I DO IF I DO NOT HAVE INTERNET ACCESS?

The Saturday session will be broadcast live on the Internet to create a simultaneous worldwide session. Those who do not have access to the internet may still meet during the Saturday morning hour and watch videos which will be included in their registration materials. These videos are presentations along the same lines as the themes which will be addressed in the Saturday session emanating from Columbus, Ohio.

17. WHAT ABOUT CHILDREN AND YOUTH?

A children (grades K thru 6) and youth (grades 7- 12) component is being planned for Sunday July 30th at Faith Ministries at 10 AM. In a fun and informative way, they too will be challenged to accept the responsibility to serve and share in the call to global missions. This session will not be broadcasted.
