Claiming CME

1. CREATE YOUR PROFILE

- Go to the www.fhcme.com website to create profile.
- Creating a profile must be done on a Laptop or Desktop only.
- Select *Create Account & Register*.
- Follow the instructions to complete profile. *Note: Email addresses are case sensitive.*

2. DOWNLOAD MOBILE APP

- Download from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store - CloudCME (All one word, do not separate).

3. SET UP YOUR MOBILE APP

- Open the app.
- You will see - *Welcome to CloudCME Check In*. To get started enter the Organization code, *flhosp*. Once the profile is created and the information is collected, you only need to activate Logging into the app once.
