The DeafBlind Projects from Delaware, Maryland, Vermont, and West Virginia developed and implemented an innovative and successful professional development program which trained an interdisciplinary team of "CVI Mentors" from each state in screening, assessment, program planning and intervention. This website was created by West Virginia's CVI Mentors. It includes video of a training covering the Overview and Characteristics of CVI, a CVI assessment, a quiz testing your level of understanding, watch a video and score two assessments, and interviews of students with CVI and their families.
