Creating eBooks Using Google Slides

There are many apps specifically designed for creating ebooks. But did you know you can easily use Google Slides (part of GAFE) to create an ebook? This link tells you how, but what it doesn't tell you is you can use text-to-speech to read the PDF you create using your Chrome extensions such as CoWriter Universal, or Select and Speak, or open on your iDevice and have it read aloud with Natural Reader (keeps graphics) or Voice Dream Reader (no graphics). Try ezPDF Reader or @Voice Aloud Reader for Android.
