Funding to Sustain Systems of Care

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Financial sustainability is a key challenge for systems of care. Emerging population health strategies require that Medicaid agencies, agency partners in systems of care, and health insurers understand the costs of care on a per-episode, per-person basis, and on state and local levels. Benchmarking allows health systems a structured approach to compare data by insurer, provider, community, and state to identify service use trends, provider activity, and hotspots. Presenters will:

- Describe funding sources used by systems of care including wraparound planning, intensive care coordination, and peer services
- Discuss how systems of care are planning to reach sustainability and highlight potential funding sources
- Outline strategies to measure and understand the costs of services and supports provided by systems of care, including financial mapping, utilization and cost studies, and benchmarking
