Orange Camp Road Widening Project Highlights

- Concept plans for widening Orange Camp Rd to 4 lanes have been prepared (see attached PDF file)
- Design will be a 4-lane divided urban typical section with a grassed median, curbs and gutters and underground stormwater drainage system.
- The intersection of Orange Camp and MLK will be fully expanded to 4 lanes on all four approach legs and dual left turn lanes will be constructed on southbound MLK to accommodate the heavy turning movements
- Endicott Way will be restricted to right in and right out due to close proximity to MLK
- A new traffic signal with pedestrian crosswalk is being proposed at Victoria Commons Blvd/Garden Club Dr intersection with Orange Camp Rd
- The existing wide sidewalk on the south side of Orange Camp Rd will be extended to connect to existing sidewalk near I-4. No sidewalk will be constructed on the north side due to very limited right of way.
- Design will include on-road 5-foot wide bike lanes from I-4 to end of project limits west of Victoria Hills Dr
- Anticipate very minimal impact to vegetative/tree buffer areas on north side of Orange Camp Rd
- Anticipate holding a public information meeting in the Spring 2017 to present preliminary engineering design plans
- Anticipate engineering design and environment/stormwater permitting to begin January 2017 with completion by December 2107
- Anticipate advertising for construction bids in January 2018 with construction complete in January/February 2019.
- Estimated construction cost is \$9 million funded by transportation impact fees and gas tax revenue bond proceeds
