and how we identify ourselves?

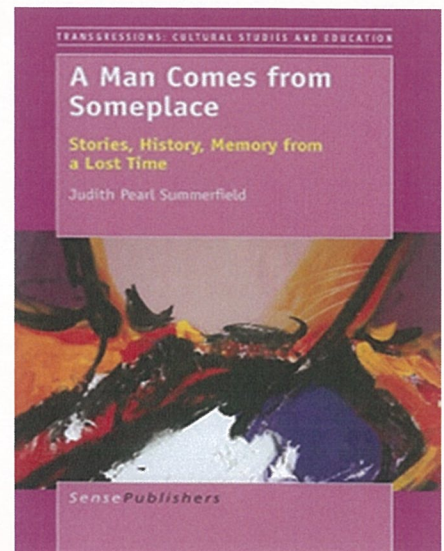
What do we mean by place:
