


Favorite toy: Any ball.

<u>Pet Mitzvah Project:</u> They love to lick your hands and face and lie on your bed to keep you company, - whether sick or not!


"Pet's Peeve": They don't like to be left at home alone and sometimes leave a sign of disapproval to greet us upon our return.

Favorite toy: Moongoose/bird


Favorite "Kosher" food, Jewish expression and/or Jewish holiday: Hanukkah

<u>Favorite toy</u>: A dangled string, a fishing line with a toy at the end – anything she can chase and pounce on.



Favorite "Kosher" food: chicken


Favorite Jewish expression: Kelev Tov

Favorite toy: Bone, rawhide chew.




"My pet seems very Jewish because...": He has a Hebrew name, Pincus, and loves all the Jewish festivals.
