

From the desk of our Executive Director Anita Bowen



What were you up to in 1978? As you know, we are currently celebrating 40 years of Boone County Senior Services, Inc. (BCSSI) and our beginning came in that year. Lots of dedicated individuals were working hard to bring this organization to fruition so that it could positively impact the quality of life for so many every year since then.



I did a little research recently on some prices from 1978 and thought you might find it interesting...

If you were driving and needed gas, you would have paid approximately 63 cents/gallon.

If you wanted to make a big breakfast with lots of bacon and eggs, you would have spent 48 cents for a dozen eggs and \$1.20 for a pound of bacon.

If you were renting an apartment 40 years ago, the average monthly rent was \$260.

In comparison to 2018, gas is running around \$2.65; eggs \$2.67 and bacon \$5.48. And, as for the rent, it has doubled and then some for most places in Indiana.

As you know, it's hard to find a cost of living that has gone down or even remained the same after 40 years! But, guess what?!

The price of participating in many events and activities at BCSSI is still FREE. There are many highlighted in this issue of *Senior Sounds*, but a few that come to mind are our weekly meals (either in Lebanon or Zionsville) that also include a special program; our monthly assistance opportunity called "Ask the Attorney" where you can get simple legal advice; our BCSSI Bookshelf that "opened" in the Lebanon lobby during 2017 and features NEW books for the taking; our coffee shop days...Coffee Connection in Lebanon & Coffee Clinic in Zionsville where cups of java of all kinds don't break the bank!

It's important to us that our programs and services are affordable to all Boone County residents. Even if they're not free, through our long-time funders and amazing community partners, we are able to keep costs lower. We try hard to not have the cost of these opportunities be the reason that you have to miss out!

We recently got some feedback through a survey that shows us that there are many residents over age 60 in Boone County who are looking to increase their social activity and to find meaningful volunteer opportunities. We hope you will help us reach those folks by inviting someone new to join you when you see something in this spring newsletter that looks interesting and fun! Give us a call, and we'll save a seat for you, and your new friend, too.

We know that spring always follows winter, and I think we're all looking forward to that promise of warmer temps and greener surroundings...and even more to do with BCSSI. *Until Next Time, Anita*

BCSSI hosted its 2018 Annual Celebration Meeting on February 14. Community members, board members and staff celebrated the agency’s 2017 accomplishments. “We’re all guilty. We’ve made an assumption about something before we got all of the details. We formed an opinion about someone simply because someone else influenced us. We came to a conclusion about what might be happening without having accurate information. **We judged a book by its cover.** It happens to Boone County Senior Services, Inc. or BCSSI all... the...time.



On one hand, we get the phone calls and the walk-ins from people who want to know about our “residents”. No one lives in this building (that we know of), except for the hard-working employees who sometimes may feel like they live here. On the other hand, there are MANY older adults in our community who wouldn’t step foot in our doors because we have that word “Senior” in our name. Quite honestly, we often just like to go by BCSSI because it’s much simpler to say --- and maybe less intimidating for some.

For sure, the vast majority of folks who make their home in Boone County have no idea that we are the public transportation provider (or the city bus) for Boone County, and it is all coordinated from our Lebanon office! Boone Area Transit System or BATS is a way for people of all ages to get around town if they don’t have access to their own vehicle.

Lastly, even though each one of us is aging, most people don’t become familiar with an organization or business in the community until they need them. Therefore, many in our county have no idea how BCSSI has been making an impact in their community.

In all of these cases, someone has judged us simply because they don’t know us. That means we still have a great challenge before us. As Boone County continues to grow and change, we want to be an integral part of helping keep the generations connected, just as we have been doing for 40 years!!

Thank you to everyone who contributes to our big “book” and we ask you to continue spreading the word so that we can get it on the best seller list!



BCSSI Spotlight: Vickie Daupert, A Daughter's Testimony

What Boone County Senior Services has done for me? I wanted to share my story of why I came to Senior Services to help with my grieving for my Dad.

It seems like yesterday, but it has been almost 4 years since my dad passed away. My Dad always seemed invincible to me, he worked out, was mentally



engaged and always there when I needed him. He really was and still is my hero. I would have never thought he would be struck by Alzheimer's. When Dad was diagnosed there was still very little

known about the disease, its side effects, and best courses of treatment. My Dad was a proud man and so to avoid having others know about his struggles we as a family decided to keep it quiet. My mom took most of the workload on that front by helping him finish his sentences and stepping up for him during social engagements. We as a family wanted to protect the man who had protected us all his life.


During this time, we were not aware of all the wonderful services Senior Services has to offer. When we did find out about it, we just were not ready to bring in other people. During this time, I had decided to

stop traveling for work to concentrate on my Dad's treatment and to provide support to my mom. Finally in February, Dad went into a nursing home to get round the clock care treatment. He passed in early March. My Dad's death was a dagger to our entire family. I personally felt like a hole was torn through my heart.

One day I was talking to a friend who was telling me about the Senior Services in Lebanon. She explained all the great work that was being done there and that it might be a place for me to help find a meaning or purpose that would allow me to honor my Dad. I went into Senior Services and met with Cindy, I was so blown away by all the great work that is being done here and was excited about the chance to make a real impact on others lives while also honoring my Dad.

I have loved my time with Senior Services, and while I am only able to come twice per week, it has been and continues to be a rewarding and fulfilling commitment. I will always miss my Dad, but being a part of the Boone County Senior Service Team has helped fill that hole in my heart. It has also helped me see that there is no shame in asking for help, caregivers are under a lot of external and internal stress. The services offered to Boone County Senior Services are so important for so many. I really don't know where I would be without this rewarding experience.

Spaghetti Alla Carbonara

1 lb. spaghetti
1/2 lb. sliced bacon
1 clove garlic

3 eggs
1/2 c. grated parmesan cheese
salt & pepper to taste

Boil spaghetti. Just before cooking spaghetti, fry bacon with clove of garlic. Drain bacon on paper, saving the grease. Discard the garlic. While the spaghetti cooks beat eggs and add the cheese, salt and pepper. As soon as spaghetti is cooked, drain. Put hot spaghetti in egg mixture and toss. When egg coats spaghetti, pour on a tablespoon of bacon fat and toss in the bacon.

This was Margot's favorite recipe because it was her daughters' favorite. Whenever the girls were given the opportunity to select a meal it was "Spaghetti Alla Cabala." Today it is Margot's granddaughters' favorite also; however Elsa likes it with extra bacon.



Cranberry-Nut Cinnamon Chex Party Mix

6 c. Cinnamon Chex cereal
1 c. walnut halves
1/4 c. packed brown sugar

1/4 c. frozen orange juice concentrate
2 T. vegetable oil
1/2 c. dried cranberries

Mix cereal and walnuts in a large microwaveable bowl. In a small microwaveable bowl, cook brown sugar, orange juice concentrate and oil on HIGH for 1 minute; stir. Microwave 1 minute longer, until hot. Pour over cereal, stirring until evenly coated. Microwave cereal mixture on HIGH 5 minutes; stirring every 2 minutes. Stir in cranberries. Spread on waxed paper or foil to cool. Store in a tightly covered container. You can use any dried fruit or nut.
