Sholosh Seudot “You Gotta be Kiddin’ Me” Halacha Discussion

As part of his training, a medical student was appointed to assist a doctor in a hospital during the night shift. The doctor was sorely overworked. He had been on duty for two days straight, with only short naps here and there to renew his strength. While the doctor rested, the student was sent to check on his patients.

The student noticed that the health of one patient had deteriorated.
