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New Family in Neighbourhood Seeking Shabbat Accommodations

Sholosh Seudot “You Gotta be Kiddin’ Me” Halacha Discussion

One Shabbos, a doctor was called to the home of a Torah-observant family to treat a case of *pikuach nefesh*. The doctor, to whom religious principles meant nothing, said that he could treat the case and save the person’s life, but he demanded to be paid on the spot. Since they did not have the cash on hand for his \$150 fee, he demanded that they write him a check. It was a matter of *pikuach nefesh*, so they agreed. When the doctor finished treating the patient, the father wrote him a check for \$200.

“You made a mistake,” said the doctor. “I asked for only \$150.”

“I made no mistake,” said the father. “It is forbidden for me to write even one unnecessary letter on Shabbos. I had to pay you to save my son’s life, but I chose to write three words on the check, ‘two hundred dollars,’ as opposed to five words, ‘one hundred and fifty dollars.’”


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Three Halachic questions arise from this Story

1. The doctor carried the check around with him for some time to show it to other people and tell the interesting story behind it.
2. Was the father actually obligated to add fifty dollars to the fee, in order to avoid desecrating Shabbos with another two words.
3. Would it have been better for him to ask the doctor who was not Shabbat observant, to write out the check?
