Sholosh Seudot Halacha Discussion

Over the course of a war, Israel's enemies found a cruel and diabolic method to protect themselves. They would hold hostages in front of themselves as human shields, forcing them to shout "Shema Yisrael", so that the Israelis would know they were Jewish. Then, they would fire over the shoulders of their captives, knowing that the Israeli soldiers would not dare return fire, for fear of harming the captives.

What is the Halachah in such a case? If an Israeli soldier is under fire, may he return fire to defend himself, even though he will kill the hostages in the process; or must he die rather than killing an innocent hostage?


