3rd Meal Question



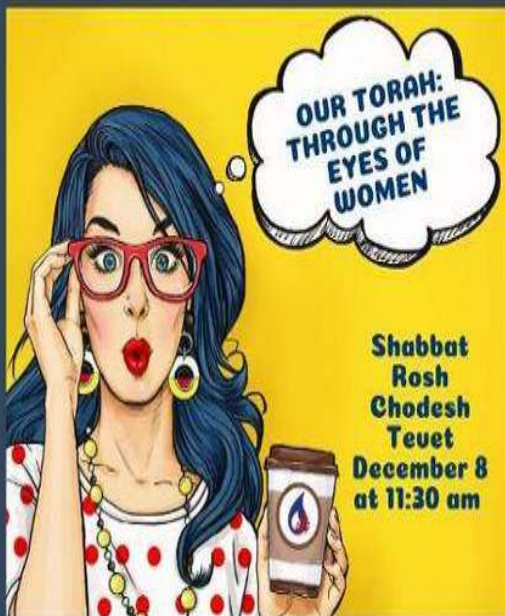
