Sholosh Seudot “You Gotta be Kiddin’ Me” Halacha Discussion

An elderly Jew named Hershel came to his dentist for a complicated treatment. Hershel suffers from nervous tension, which made it very difficult for the dentist to complete the treatment. Again and again, Hershel interfered, since he was scared of what the dentist might do. The dentist lost his patience and demanded that Hershel let him finish his job without interruptions and without screaming, but Hershel could not control himself. Finally, the dentist got so upset that he slapped Hershel across the face.

At that point, Hershel went absolutely hysterical. The dentist realized that he had gone too far and asked for forgiveness. “I am so sorry I lost my cool,” he said. He offered to pay Hershel a thousand dollars if he would forgive him and not publicize the story or complain to the police.

“A thousand dollars isn’t enough to pay for this outrage”, said Hershel. “I demand ten thousand dollars to keep quiet about this.”

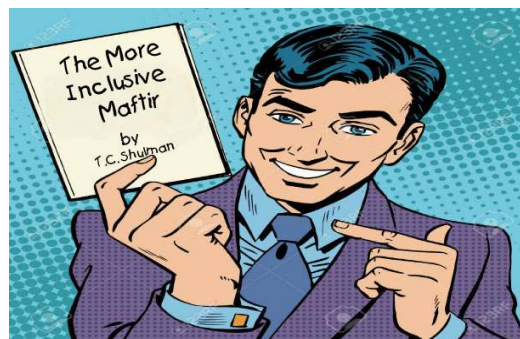

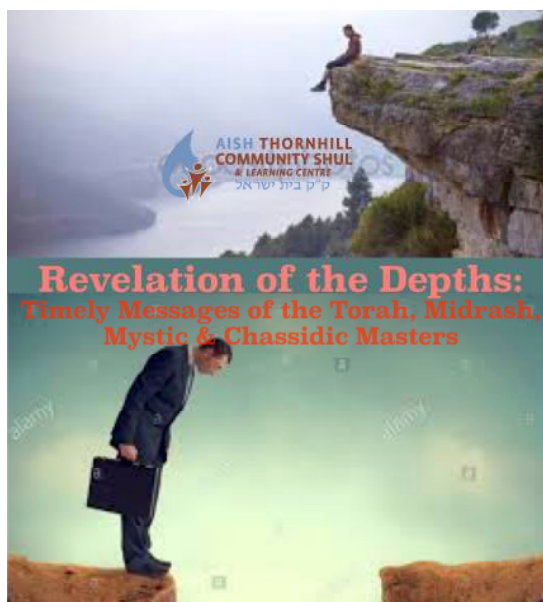

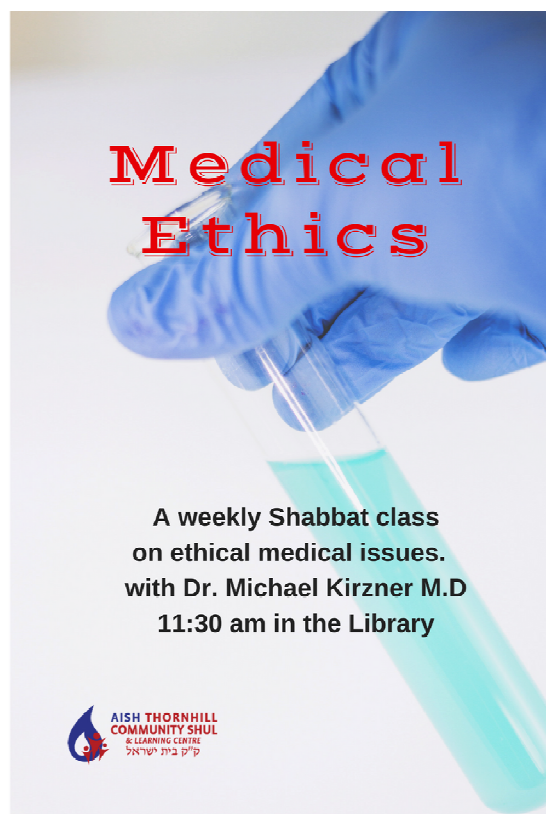
