Sholosh Seudot Halacha Discussion

Tzachi was a baker who lived on a kibbutz. Throughout his life, he carefully guarded the recipe for a special cake that had become famous throughout Israel. Only his family knew the secret recipe, which they guarded even from their closest friends. After Tzachi passed away, his friends decided to memorialize him in a creative and unusual way. They carved the recipe for the famous cake on his tombstone.

Years passed and the wave of *teshuvah* that spread throughout Israel reached this kibbutz as well. The baker's son became a *ba'al teshuvah* and began to feel misgivings about the last "honour" he had afforded his father. Not only did it seem disrespectful, he wondered if he was allowed to let people come and read a recipe off a tombstone. The Shulchan Aruch states that it is forbidden to derive any benefit from things made and used for the honour of the deceased. If so, perhaps even the cakes they baked from that recipe would be forbidden.

What should he do? Find out during Sholosh Seudot with Rabbi Rothman


