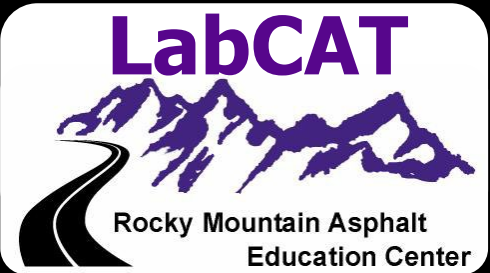

The Rocky Mountain Asphalt Education Center hosted 531 attendees thru the Laboratory Certification for Asphalt Technicians (LabCAT) and Roadway Inspector Certification Programs in 2017.

CDOT and CAPA renewed their 5-Year agreement (2018—2022) for CAPA to administer the LabCAT program.



92% of all attendees rated the benefit of the certification programs as **Good to Excel-**

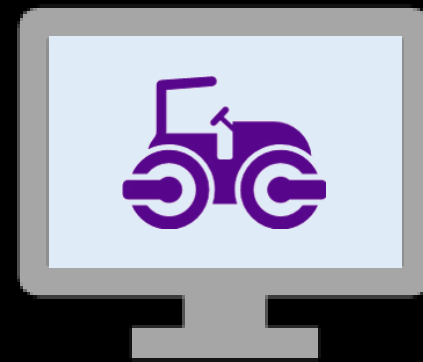
99% of all attendees rated the overall quality of the certification programs as **Good to Excellent**
