They too are mobilizing on a local level to bring community together in a creative and nurturing way through the creation of the [Mainspring Center](#). It was here that my hope for the future of politics was restored. Why? Because Mark is the kind of person that leads with his heart and his head. As a trained family therapist for community health organizations, he has been on the front lines learning that you don't give up on folks when they are struggling... You listen. You are present. And you work together to make real and meaningful change.

PROFESSIONAL: Mark served eight years in the Maine House of Representatives, including two terms as Speaker of the House. He has spent most of his time working to bring together a state that can feel awfully divided. It was under Mark's leadership that the legislature

- Passed a bipartisan middle-class tax cut
- Boosted property tax relief for all Maine families
- Strengthened investments in Maine's children, seniors and workers.

ISSUES: As an Occupational Therapist, I have been in the trenches with our dysfunctional healthcare system and have witnessed Seniors not getting the support that they need when they are at their most vulnerable. Mark has a history of working with this underserved population & is working towards ending housing waitlists by providing affordable senior housing, lowering property taxes and providing greater support for family members to be supported financially through the role of caretaker. Other issues that he is working on:

- Improving Education: Support Students, Parents & Teachers
- Putting a stop to Gun Violence
- Addressing Jobs & the Economy
- Protecting the Environment
- Ending the Drug Epidemic

PERSONAL: Mark lives in North Berwick with his wife Laura, their three young children, four goats, two pigs and a coop full of chickens.
