Scholarship - includes return flight from Australia to Israel, visa, accommodation and monthly living allowance. Interviews will be held in Melbourne or via teleconference December 2017.

Applications should be lodged by 11 December 2017.

With some 6,000 species, the Jerusalem Botanical Gardens hold Israel's largest plant collection.

The Gardens cover 30 acres and are divided into six phyto-geographical sections: Australia, Mediterranean, North America, Europe, Southern Africa, and Central and SW Asia. The Gardens also have a tropical conservatory and are centrally located in Jerusalem, adjacent to Hebrew University. The scholarship, now in its 5th year, provides an opportunity to explore an exciting culture and lifestyle while working and learning with a highly skilled, welcoming and dedicated team at the Jerusalem Botanical Gardens.
