Hesperaloe parviflora 'MSWNPERED' P.P.#28910 Sandia Glow™



New to the market this year, another exclusive *Hesperaloe* selection, **Sandia Glow**TM. This plant is the product of nearly to twenty years of breeding Hesperaloes at our nursery down in Cochise county, and is the progeny of hundreds of thousands of plants in field trials. Sandia GlowTM is a remarkably vigorous selection of *Hesperaloe parviflora* that will reach a mature size of 2 to 3 feet tall and wide within just a few seasons of planting. From our observations, this great new selection has a tremendously long bloom season, especially in the low desert. Plants will start their bloom stalks in March and they will continue long into the summer, ours still were blooming a month after we hit 118 degrees here in Phoenix last June. Much like our widely popular Brakelights® selection, the Sandia GlowTM will bloom again in the

fall once summer temperatures subside providing nearly year-round color. The flower color is a vibrant watermelon red that will open to a creamy yellow interior. This selection is nearly sterile, which will provide for increased flower production since the plant will not devote its efforts to seed production. Sandia GlowTM is adaptable to many different planting locations: it can thrive on full sun and reflected heat but also grow well in partial shade. Plant Sandia GlowTM with some of our other selections such as Desert DuskTM or 'Pink Parade' to provide a great show of color with overlapping seasons. Like all *Hesperaloes*, these plants prefer well-draining soil and limited water once established. Sandia GlowTM is nearly maintenance-free, the only care required in the landscape would be to remove the spent flower stalks after they are done blooming.
