This Week's Ministry Opportunities

1) Southeast Testament Mission Trip: October 21

Join the SET Team for the annual fall trip for maintenance, repair and improvement projects to the building and grounds. There are projects for all including cleaning, painting, donation center organization, planting/clearing, cutting/splitting firewood, power washing, meal planning and preparation. (Friday-Sunday option may also be available).

2) The Journey—Prayer: Classes Begin Oct. 22, 9:50am

Come deepen and discover different paths of your *Inward Journey* through a 4-week class on prayer. Pastoral Intern Jared Howard will lead this Sunday class in the Fireside Lounge where we will explore the "why", experience different types of prayer and meditation, and explore biblical examples of prayer.



3) Hands-Only CPR Class: Oct. 17, 10:30am, Fellowship Hall

Hands-On CPR is a non-certified entry-level class, and is an orientation and awareness of the basics of CPR and AED use. This one-hour training will emphasize the importance of quick emergency response time - the most crucial being those 3-7 minutes before first-responders arrive. Cost: \$10
