Peace Prayer Beads

Today you will receive a tangible way to express your Inward and Outward Journey. These prayer beads require minimal assembly and come with a guide, explaining how to use the beads in your daily lives. We encourage people of all ages to set aside time to intentionally pray with your prayer beads. Pick up yours on the Communion Tables today!

Silver: Inhale and exhale a few times to center yourself in prayer.
Red: Gratitude “*Today I am thankful for...*”
Purple: Confessional “*Help me to...*” or “*Forgive me for...*”
Cross: Jesus Christ is at the center of our lives.
Blue: Family “*I pray for family and friends close to me...*”
Green: World “*I pray for neighbors near and around the world...*”
Silver: Inhale and exhale again to conclude your prayer.
