

## Huber's Bistro 22 Dempsey Road 6737 1588 | hubers.com.sg

We arrived for lunch on a Friday, bang on midday, and the bistro was filling up fast. Indoors had a casual and cosy feel, with plenty more seating spilling outside. Preparing ourselves for a meaty marathon, we ordered a charcuterie starter, *tagliere di affettati misti* (\$14.80), including Parma ham, salami and mortadella ham, as well as some deliciously juicy olives. Feeling we should add some vegetables to the mix, we also enjoyed a **spinach and rocket salad** (\$11.90) – this remained unfinished only because we wanted to have enough space to enjoy our mains.

Australian pasture-fed lamb chops (\$24) with vegetables and a warm roast beef sandwich (\$12.80) with soft brioche bread came next, both served with a pile of fries. Unsurprisingly, the lamb and thin slices of sirloin beef were fresh and full of

flavour, and went down well with a glass of Provençal rosé (\$9.50) and another of Côtes du Rhone (\$9.80).

Unfortunately we had no room for dessert, only coffee, though the menu promises a selection of Mövenpick ice creams as well as daily specials. The bistro also offers three dishes in child-sized portions, and the big bonus is the large outdoor playground, making this Dempsey spot extremely popular with families on the weekend.

Must-try: The Australian pasture-fed lamb chops.

**Tip:** The bistro doesn't take reservations. It opens at 11am from Tuesday to Friday, at 9.30am on Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays, and is closed on Mondays.
