

Mechirat Hametz - The Selling of Hametz

Note: If possible, all hametz – food not acceptable during Pesach (Passover), or materials containing such unacceptable food should be destroyed or given away before the holiday begins. Should this be impossible, the hametz may be stored in such a way that we are sure not to use it during the holiday and its actual ownership is transferred to a non-Jew until the holiday ends.
