

## Easy Knit Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and needles to match.

Instructions:

Cast on 4 stitches

Row 1: Knit 4

Row 2: Knit 2, yarn over, knit across the row.

Repeat Row 2 until one side edge of your triangle measures 12".

Row 3: Knit 1, Knit 2 together, yarn over, knit 2 together, knit to the end of the row.

Repeat Row 3 until you have 4 stitches on the needle. Bind off.

## Easy Crocheted Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and crochet hook to match.

Work in the back loops for the entire pattern.

Instructions:

Ch 4, turn.

Row 1: sc in each st, ch 1 and turn (3 sts)

Row 2: sc inc in first st, sc in each st across, sc inc in last st, ch 1 and turn

Rep Row 2 until one side edge of your triangle measures 12".

Row 3: sc2tog, sc in each st across to last 2 sts, sc2tog.

Repeat row 3 until you have 3 sts left, fasten off and weave in ends.

## Waffle Rib Stitch Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and needles to match.

Waffle Rib Stitch (Multiple of 3+1):

Row 1: \* K1, P2, rep from \* to last stitch, K1

Row 2: \* P1, K2, rep from \* to last stitch, P1

Row 3: Knit All


Row 4: Purl All

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Cast on a multiple of 3 stitches + 1. Work Waffle Rib Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to cast on to get the correct width for your square.

Cast on Multiple of 3 stitches + 1, enough to measure 12" across. Repeat rows 1-4 of Waffle Rib pattern until block measures 12". Bind off.

---

## Box Stitch Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and needles to match.

Box Stitch (Multiple of 4+2):

Row 1: \* K2, P2, rep from \* to last 2 stitches, K2

Row 2: P2, \* K2, P2, rep from \* to end.

Row 3: Rep row 2.

Row 4: Rep row 1.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Cast on a multiple of 4 stitches + 2. Work Box Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to cast on to get the correct width for your square.

Cast on Multiple of 4 stitches + 2, enough to measure 12" across. Repeat rows 1-4 of Box Stitch pattern until block measures 12". Bind off.

---

## Basketweave Stitch Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and needles to match.

Box Stitch (Multiple of 6+2):

Row 1 - right side: Knit.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: Knit 2, \* purl 4, knit 2; repeat from \* to end.

Row 4: Purl 2, \* knit 4, purl 2; repeat from \* to end.

Row 5: Knit 2, \* purl 4, knit 2; repeat from \* to end.

Row 6: Purl 2, \* knit 4, purl 2; repeat from \* to end.

Row 7: Knit.

Row 8: Purl.

Row 9: Purl 3, \* knit 2, purl 4; repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, knit 2, purl 3.

Row 10: Knit 3, \* purl 2, knit 4; repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, purl 2, knit 3.

Row 11: Purl 3, \* knit 2, purl 4; repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, knit 2, purl 3.

Row 12: Knit 3, \* purl 2, knit 4; repeat from \* to last 5 stitches, purl 2, knit 3.

Repeat Rows 1 - 12.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Cast on a multiple of 6 stitches + 2. Work Basketweave Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to cast on to get the correct width for your square.

Cast on Multiple of 6 stitches + 2, enough to measure 12" across. Repeat rows 1-12 of Basketweave Stitch pattern until block measures 12". Bind off.

---

**NOTE: For the following stitch patterns, it is helpful for seaming purposes to add a 2 stitch garter stitch edge to each side of your work.**

## Diamond Brocade Stitch Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and needles to match.

Diamond Brocade Stitch (Multiple of 8+1):

Row 1 (Right side): Knit 4, \* purl 1, knit 7; rep from \* to last 5 sts, purl 1, k 4.

Row 2: Purl 3, \* knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 5; rep from \* to last 6 sts, knit 1, purl 1, knit 1, purl 3.

Row 3: Knit 2, \* purl 1, knit 3; rep from \* to last 3 sts, purl 1, knit 2.

Row 4: Purl 1, \* knit 1, purl 5, knit 1, purl 1; rep from \* to end.

Row 5: \* Purl 1, knit 7; rep from \* to last st, purl 1.

Row 6: Repeat Row 4.

Row 7: Repeat Row 3.

Row 8: Repeat Row 2.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Cast on a multiple of 8 stitches + 1. Work Diamond Brocade Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to cast on to get the correct width for your square.

Cast on Multiple of 8 stitches + 1, enough to measure 12" across. Repeat rows 1-8 of Diamond Brocade Stitch pattern until block measures 12". Bind off.

---

### Shell Stitch Crocheted Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and crochet hook to match.

Shell Stitch (Multiple of 3+2):

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook. \*Ch 3, skip 2 chs, sc in next, repeat from \* across. Turn.

Row 2: This will be considered the Right Side of your piece. Ch 3, (counts as 1 dc here and throughout). Dc in Same st as ch 3. Sc in ch 3 sp, \* 3 dc in next sc, sc in next ch 3 sp. Repeat from \* across. 2 dc in last sc. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 1. Sc in same st as ch 1. \* Ch 3, sk next 3 sts, sc in next (this will be the middle dc of shell from previous row). Repeat from \* across, placing your last sc in top of turning ch 3. Turn

Repeat rows 2 & 3.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Chain a multiple of 3 stitches + 2. Work Shell Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to chain to get the correct width for your square.

Chain a Multiple of 3 stitches + 2, enough to measure 12" across. Work Shell stitch pattern until block measures 12".

---

### Offset Filet Net Crocheted Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and crochet hook to match.

Offset Filet Net Stitch (Multiple of 2+3):

Row 1: Dc in 5th ch from hook (counts as 1 dc + ch 1), \* ch1, sk 1 ch, dc in next, repeat from \* until the end of the row, turn.

Row 2: ch 4 (counts as 1 dc + ch1), sk 1 dc, \*dc in ch 1 sp, ch 1, sk 1 dc repeat until the end. Place 1 dc under (not through) the 4th turning ch. Turn. Repeat row 2.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Chain a multiple of 2 stitches + 3. Work Offset Filet Net Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to chain to get the correct width for your square.

Chain a Multiple of 2 stitches + 3, enough to measure 12" across. Work Offset Filet Net Stitch pattern until block measures 12".

---

### Crunch Stitch Crocheted Afghan Square



Materials: Machine Washable and Dryable Yarn and crochet hook to match.

Crunch Stitch (Multiple of 2):

Row 1: skip 2ch (count as 1 hdc), \*sl st into next ch, 1 hdc into next ch; rep from \* ending sl st into last ch, turn.

Row 2: 2ch (count as 1 hdc), skip 1 st, \*sl st into next hdc, 1 hdc into next sl st; rep from \* ending sl st into top of tch, turn.

Repeat row 2.

Step 1: Measure your gauge. Chain a multiple of 2. Work Crunch Stitch for a few repeats. Measure the number of stitches per inch you are getting, and use that number to determine how many you'll need to chain to get the correct width for your square.

Chain a Multiple of 2, enough to measure 12" across. Work crunch stitch pattern until block measures 12".
