Message from Thack

The 48th Diocesan Convention concluded last Saturday at noon. St. Andrew's-By-The-Sea was the host parish and along with the other congregations in that convocation, they demonstrated wonderful hospitality to the visitors from around the Diocese.

The theme for this year's convention was *Being the Church*. Russell incorporated the theme into his sermon for the opening service Thursday night. To this end, Russell gave his "Bishop's Address" as part of his sermon. It was a hopeful message that addressed, among other things, the increase in parochial giving to the Diocese, the many new Diocesan programs, and the activities of the Diocesan Youth Commission.

He also spoke about the cultural shift in our country and touched on the relevance of the Church today in the 21st Century. To this end, he said a way of living that helps keep the church relevant is through *engagement*. It is a call to a deeper awareness of the context and culture beyond the walls of the church. Russell asked the following questions, "Do we truly know where our churches sit? Do we know the needs of our neighbors?" Engagement is the work of learning about where our churches sit and responding to the context and culture around us.

St. Paul's is addressing these questions through the Congregational Enrichment Venture (CEV) program. Our parish, along with eleven others from around the Diocese, have been meeting to learn how to better understand our surrounding neighbors. Our relevance will depend on how well we meet the needs of the people in our environs. This will require us to step outside our comfort zones and seek out and personally engage our neighbors. Our CEV committee hopes to share these skills to St. Paul's once we've completed the CEV program.

Your delegates to the convention represented St. Paul's well. Our delegates were Howard Wilson, Beverly Koepp, Jessica Sawyer, Bill Harrison and Terri McMillan. Bell Jackson was invited by Bishop Russell to serve as a Youth Delegate and also represented St. Paul's well. Her video montage from the most recent Happening was shown during Saturday's business session and was well received by Russell and all the delegates. Finally, Nancy Bolton Beck was appointed by Bishop Russell to serve a term as a member of the Racial Reconciliation Commission.

One of the highlights of the convention was preparing 43,500 meals Friday afternoon. In lieu of the traditional gala on Friday night, all the delegates convened at the Destin Community Center and packed 43,500 meals to help feed the homeless and destitute. Besides helping to take care of the needs of those less fortunate than ourselves, this was a tangible example of what it's like *being the church*. We all thoroughly enjoyed this and our delegates hope this becomes an annual tradition.

The biggest take away for me was the hopeful and joyful spirit that seemed to pervade the convention. Only a few years ago, the Diocese of the Central Gulf Coast was a loose confederation of congregations with no real sense of community or direction. The diocesan budget had declined to a critical level and a corporate sense of malaise seemed to have set in. This has changed over the last several years and this recent convention reminded me of previous conventions in the 1980's and 1990's. We all seemed to be pulling together in the same direction with an optimistic spirit.

This convention was a wonderful and inspirational homecoming. With engaged and inspired leadership, a corporate sense of community, and a realistic vision, I anticipate even greater things for St. Paul's and the Diocese in the future. It is really a good time to be an Episcopalian!
