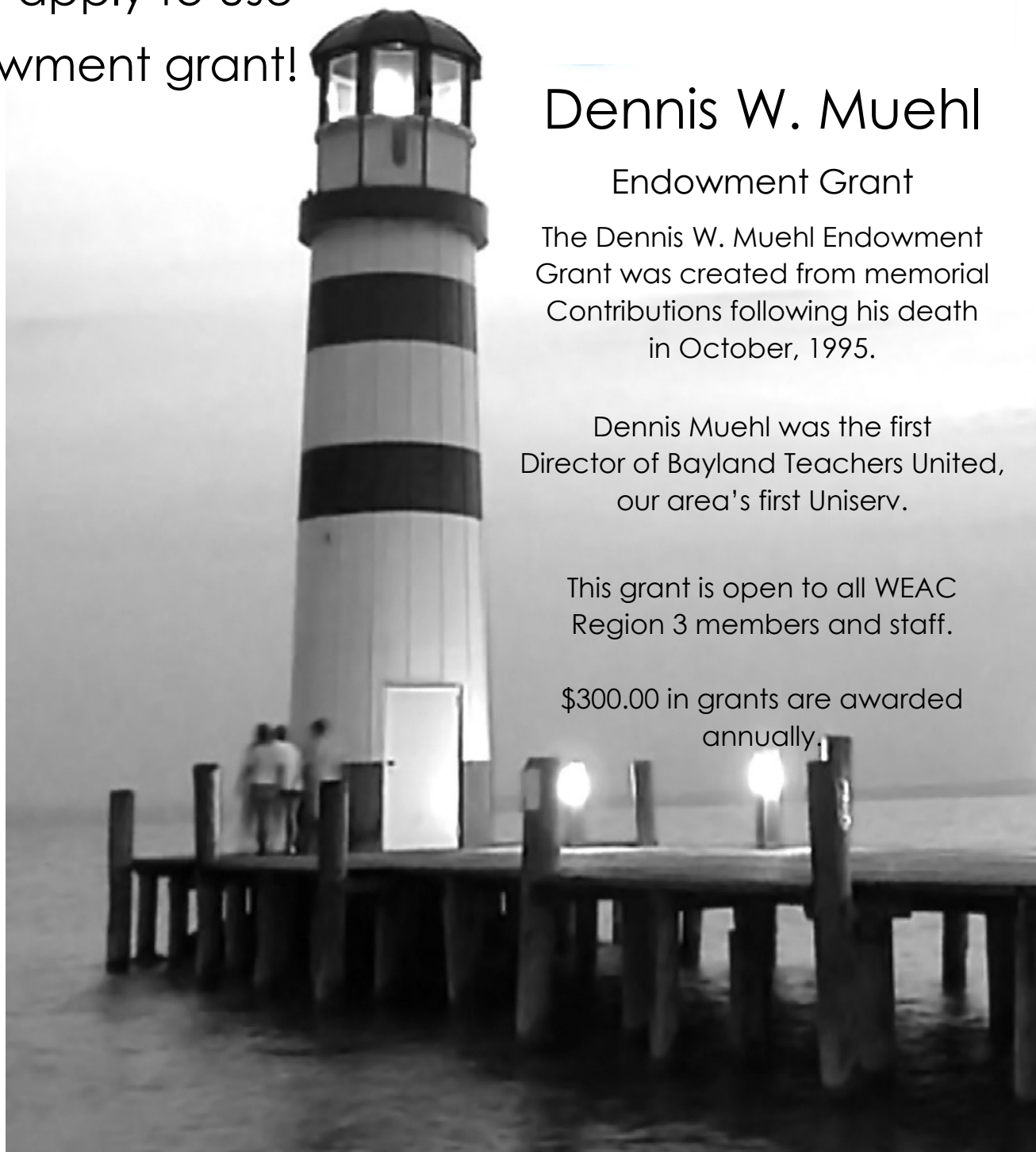
Endowment Grant
