2018 BRONZE MEDAL NOMINATION AND SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

The Bronze Medal is the highest award given by AIA Utah to an architect member. Its purpose is to recognize a body of significant architectural design work and / or lasting contributions through teaching, service to the community, and / or service to the profession. This Award is not given posthumously. One award may be given annually. This award will be determined by jury.

ELIGIBILITY

Architect Members of AIA Utah in good standing are eligible to be nominated. If good standing is in question, please contact the AIA Utah office and request membership verification.

Please submit the following items in PDF format online in the order listed below.

1. A one-page (one-side) statement, in PDF format describing why this person should receive the award. **Please succinctly highlight nominee's contributions and their impacts.**
2. A resume, bio or CV of the nominee that includes his or her education, work history, present work role and project responsibilities, and professional contributions and service activities in PDF format.

At least four individual, one-page (one-side) letters of support in a single PDF file for the nominee. **No less than three letters** shall be from AIA members in good standing from any membership category. Letters should address the nominees' specific works that are suited for this award and the impacts of that work.

3. Supporting materials which demonstrate the contributions which may include:

- a) Up to 15 individual pages of images showing examples of the individual's body of architectural work. **Images must be identified with project name and photographer credit.** Limit image size to 8x10 inches at 300 dpi.
- b) Up to 10 pages of additional information, such as copies of clippings, articles, or other items to convey the accomplishments of the nominee.

THIS WILL RESULT IN A PDF FILE OF NO MORE THAN 25 PAGES.

Submittals are due electronically to AIA Utah staff with a time stamp of no later than 5:00 p.m. Friday, October 19, 2018. Submissions will be accepted by direct upload to this link:
