Did you know that Western Hills has a Children's Library? It is located in Room 105. You can come visit any time that class is not in session.



The two year old class is led by director Heather Hogan, teachers Jessica and John Boose, Amanda Stice, Megan Holmes and Aiden Norton. Six to ten active youngsters are having a blast both hours each Sunday as they are loved and learning through their senses and active play.

Every Sunday, the morning begins with prayer and a story from the Bible. The children then get to relate these lessons to the world around them thru play, song, and art. Every week there are new activities and toys to keep class interesting and exciting. This is done by setting up stations relating to our Bible lesson that the children can visit and explore. Heart Western Hills' New Disability Ministry

"Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and bring in the poor, the crippled, the blind and the lame... Go out to the roads and country lanes and make them come in, so that my house will be full." Luke 14:21b, 23

My heart yearns to seek out this often forgotten people group and invite them in. It is estimated that worldwide there are up to 600 million people who live with a disability; 54 million are in the United States. The majority of these people with disabilities do not attend church. It is our desire for them to come to know our loving Jesus Christ as their own personal Lord, Savior and Friend.

Joni and Friend's Studies (founder Joni Eareckson Tada) have found that less than 11% of churches do any type of intentional outreach to people affected by disability. Only 15% of families affected by disabilities are raising their children as part of a church community.

I feel that this is generally due to the fact that churches are not equipped to serve individuals with disabilities in our classrooms and activities. My hope is that Western Hills will be the place in Topeka that our friends with disabilities and their families feel safe and free to learn about the love of Jesus.

January 21st at 9:00 am, we will begin offering a **Small Group class** for individuals with disabilities ages High School – Adult. We will also begin providing **Friendship Partners** for individuals with disabilities ages toddler – middle school to assist them in their age group classroom as well as assisting ages high school – adults at other church activities they may want to attend (this will also allow their family/caregiver to attend church or another small group & activities).

OUR NEED: We are especially looking for volunteers in the role of friendship partners. We can also utilize additional class assistant and substitute teachers
