The Delta Visual Arts Show is held in a number of venues in downtown Newport, Arkansas. The show will open to the public at 10 am and remain open until 6 pm. Each venue will be dedicated to a specific type of art and all the artists in that venue (unless otherwise noted on the Booth Layout Sheets) will fall into the category for the building.

Episcopal Church Parish House – This venue will be dedicated to Functional Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 10 booths in this venue. The address for the Episcopal Church Parish House is 301 Hazel Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this facility.

First Baptist Church Fellowship Hall – This venue will be dedicated to Functional Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 19 booths in this venue. The address for the First Baptist Church Family Life Center is 553 Second Street, Newport, AR 72112 Street parking is adjacent to this venue.

NEW First Baptist Church Foyer – The First Baptist Church Family Life Center Foyer will be dedicated to Outsider Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 4 booths in this venue. The address for the First Baptist Church Family Life Center is 553 Second Street, Newport, AR 72112 Street parking is adjacent to this venue.

First Baptist Church Gym – The First Baptist Church Family Life Center Gym will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 49 booths in this venue. The address for the First Baptist Church Family Life Center is 553 Second Street, Newport, AR 72112 Street parking is adjacent to this venue.

NEW First Baptist Church Upstairs – The First Baptist Church Family Life Center Upstairs floor will be dedicated to the Literary Arts (see page __ for a description). The Author's Corner will be located on this floor as will all of the author readings and presentations. There will be 29 booths in this venue. The address for the First Baptist Church Family Life Center is 553 Second Street, Newport, AR 72112 Street parking is adjacent to this venue.

First United Methodist Church – The First United Methodist Church Fellowship Hall will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 15 booths in this venue. The address for the First United Methodist Church is 3rd and Laurel Streets, Newport, AR 72112 A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

NEW Frankie's Place – *This is a new venue this year and is the live music venue.* Frankie's Place is dedicated to the Musical Arts (see page __ for a description) and it will feature live music performances from 10 am until 6 pm. The address for Frankie's Place is 306 Front Street, AR 72112. A parking lot is across the street from this venue.

NEW Future Museum Building – The Future Museum Building will feature Craft Arts (see page __ for a description). There are 26 booths in this venue. The address for the Future Museum Building is 321 3rd Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

Grimes Building – The Grimes Building will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 9 booths in this venue. The Grimes Building address is 416 Second Street, Newport, AR 72112. Street parking is adjacent to this venue.

Iron Mountain Train Depot – The Iron Mountain Train Depot will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 19 booths in this venue. The address for the Iron Mountain Train Depot is 501 Front Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

Newport Business Resource Center – The Newport Business Resource Center will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 21 booths in this venue. The address for the Newport Business Resource Center is 201 Hazel Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

Shear Magic Building – The Shear Magic Building will be dedicated to the Fine Arts (see page __ for a description). There will be 12 booths in this venue. The address for the Shear Magic Building is 312 Front Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is across the street from this venue.

Walnut Street Tent – The Walnut Street Tent will feature a variety of categories of art as well as some food options. There will be 16 booths in this venue. The address for the Walnut Street Tent is 200 Walnut Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

W.A. Billingsley Library - Adult Workshops – Adult workshops will be held at the W.A. Billingsley Library located at 213 Walnut Street, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

Children's Workshops – Children's workshops and the children's art contest will be held in the First United Methodist Church Sunday School Annex. The First United Methodist Church address is the corner of Third and Laurel Streets, Newport, AR 72112. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

This is the Delta Art Contest – The contest will be held upstairs in the Newport Business Resource Center, 201 Hazel Street, Newport, Arkansas. A parking lot is adjacent to this venue.

Definitions of Art Classifications

The Art Classifications have been assigned by the Art Show Steering Committee based on both each artists description of the art they would bring to the show and the art that artists have featured at their booth in the past.

Fine Art – Art as an expression of emotion and skill which has a primary esthetic purpose and no practical use (primarily painting, sculpture, photography, decorative glass work, etc.)

Functional Art – Art as an expression of emotion and skill which has a functional purpose but is produced to have a significant esthetic component that would not be thought of as common for that type product (primarily jewelry, decorative furniture, functional pottery, wood working, and artistic practical items like pens, knives and lamps, etc.)

Craft Art – Art as an expression of emotion and skill that is more repetitive in its creation and composed of more functional items and primarily for a decorative, household or personal use and which uses materials not traditionally associated with fine arts (primarily decorative signs, painting with words or phrases, yard art, seasonal art, textiles, hanging art made from metal or wood, homemade soaps, etc.)

Outsider Art – Art as an expression of emotion and skill that uses media outside the mainstream of fine art or produced by artists that are outside the mainstream of artists, but that uses several of the tools of fine art (painting on wood, cardboard or other media; or using themes, media or artists from outside the fine art mainstream while using oils or other fine arts materials, etc.)

Literary Art – Art through the written word as an expression of emotion and skill, information and thought in a variety of written forms (works of poetry, fiction and non-fiction of varying lengths and styles, etc.)

Musical Art – Rhythmic art produced vocally or on any of a wide variety of instruments as an expression of emotion and skill (live musical performances in a wide variety of genres)




