Did you know that according to the Times of Israel, the largest Sukkah in the world this year will be in Jerusalem? (This shouldn't be a huge surprise). The Jerusalem municipality Safra Square Sukkah next to City Hall is 11,000 square feet, can fit over 1000 people at once, and will host over 100,000 people over the course of the Chag. Tel Aviv also has a massive Sukkah built near the Port by Beit Tefillah Israeli. This one is 7,000 square feet and expects to host 25,000 people over the chag.


