

MOSHE'S HANDS IN THE AIR

("CAUSE HE DOES HAVE A CARE")

It was bound to happen sooner or later, but who would have believed a nation would get up the guts so soon to attack *Bnai Yisrael*. After witnessing so many miracles and the divine strength of *Hashem*, you'd think Amalek would be shaking in their boots. But Amalek descends from Esav and they're willing to tempt fate for a chance to clobber *Bnai Yisrael*. As Amalek approaches, Moshe figures he'd better send his best *tzadikim* into battle. Amalek will then understand the awesome power of *Hashem* and realize that, only with *Hashem's* help, Amalek's weapons are worthless. Moshe appoints his student Yehoshua to gather an army.

Moshe decides that he'll daven to *Hashem* on the top of a hill where all the Jewish soldiers can observe him. Moshe holds up his hands to the sky and begins to pray.
