ABR® Designation Requirements

1. Be an Active NAR Member

You must be an active member of the National Association of REALTORS®

2. Complete the (2 -Day) ABR® Designation Course (This Course)

3. Become a REBAC Member—1st Year Free

The ABR® Designation Core Course includes a free one year REBAC membership when the course provider notifies REBAC of your successful course completion.

4. Complete One Elective Course

You must complete one approved ABR® elective course within 3 years of completing this ABR® Core Course. (List of courses will be provided during ABR® Core Course.)

5. Submit a Designation Application Documenting Transactions

Complete an ABR® designation application including documentation of 5 closed transactions in which you represented the buyer. Valid transactions include any closed prior to and up to 36 months after ABR® Designation Core Course completion.

6. Ongoing REBAC & NAR Membership

You must maintain membership in REBAC and NAR or one of its international cooperating associations.
