Your council members voted to join MCE to give you the opportunity to purchase more renewable, competitively-priced electricity as an alternative to PG&E's energy supply. In September, your electric account will be switched to MCE's Light Green renewable energy service, unless you choose another option. For the average home, the cost for this 50% renewable energy will be slightly cheaper than PG&E's 30% renewable energy supply.

# What is MCE?

MCE is a not-for-profit, public agency that works with PG&E to provide your electric service. MCE provides 50-100% renewable energy from solar, wind, bioenergy, geothermal and hydroelectricity at stable and competitive rates so that you can help protect our environment. That means a brighter world for us and future generations!

## MCE Napa County is coming soon.

The cities of Napa County voted to join MCE, a not-for-profit, public agency that partners with PG&E to provide electricity generated from more renewable, non-polluting sources. Formed by the public to buy cleaner power and invest in our local economies, MCE has served Bay Area electric customers since 2010 and unincorporated Napa County customers since 2015. As an MCE customer, you'll join us on a path toward a cleaner planet by reducing your carbon footprint and helping Napa County lower its greenhouse gas emissions.

## What does MCE offer Napa County?

MCE offers a choice for energy providers where there was none before. As a local government agency and as a public servant, MCE is always working in the best interest of our member communities.

MCE does not use taxpayer dollars and reinvests in communities by providing low and stable rates, fostering local renewable development projects, and expanding energy efficiency programs.

MCE has more than 193 megawatts (MW) of new California clean energy under development including a 10.5 MW solar project in Richmond. MCE's contracted power projects have supported more than 2,400 California jobs.

## How MCE works with PG&E

Electricity services can be understood in two categories: electric delivery and electric generation. PG&E continues to

deliver your electricity, maintain and repair power lines, and send your monthly bill, all at the same costs and level of service that you're used to. MCE will buy and build cleaner energy supply for you, called electric generation.

PG&E continues to send one monthly bill. Bills look almost exactly the same, except MCE's generation charges replace what PG&E would have charged you for their generation.

### MCE Light Green | 50% renewable energy

Take no action, and you'll be enrolled in Light Green. Light Green is guaranteed to be 50% or more renewable and is currently over 63% greenhouse gas free.

### MCE Deep Green | 100% renewable energy

Imagine all your electricity is pollution-free. It is when you choose Deep Green 100% renewable energy service. It costs 1¢ more per kilowatt-hour — about \$5 per month for the typical home — than Light Green. Half of this premium funds the development of new, local renewable sites like MCE Solar One in Richmond.

### MCE Local Sol | 100% local solar energy

100% of the electricity for Local Sol customers will be produced at the Cooley Quarry Solar Project, currently under construction in Novato, CA.

### PG&E | 30% renewable energy\*

You can always choose to opt out and keep PG&E's basic 30% renewable generation service or one of their other options.
