

Parshat Nasso

In parshat Nasso, the Leviim are first counted by family, and then the group is summed. The commentators explain that this is akin to a rich man who first goes through his possessions one by one, appreciating each one individually, and then reflecting back on the total of his riches. Thus it is with Hashem, celebrating both each individual Levi and then the Leviim as a group.
