To: Town of Holden Beach Mayor, Commissioners, and Town Manager

At the May 27, 2017, meeting of the Holden Beach Property Owners Association (HBPOA), there was discussion regarding parking problems on the island. Members discussed the verbal abuse and trash associated with people parking on their properties. One member described how Town police officers visited his house and threatened fines and jail time if he did not remove a fence to allow people to park on his lawn.

A motion was made for the HBPOA to send a letter to the Town Commissioners requesting their help in preventing parking on improved properties, and recommending that the Town communicate with property owners regarding right-of-way issues by letter instead of sending police officers to their house. The motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

Therefore, Holden Beach Property Owners Association requests that the Commissioners and the Town of Holden Beach prevent parking on improved properties, and communicate by letter regarding right-of-way issues with property owners.
