Grade Level Assignments:

Preschool: Individually wrapped candy and mints

Kindergarten: Chocolate

First Grade: Puzzles

Second Grade: Adult coloring books and colored pencils

Third Grade: Playing cards and card games

Fourth Grade: Puzzle books – crossword, word search, Sudoku

Fifth Grade: Stationary, notebooks, pens

Middle School: Men's and Women's bathing products – body wash, lotion, body spray, nail polish, lip gloss, chap stick, etc.
