

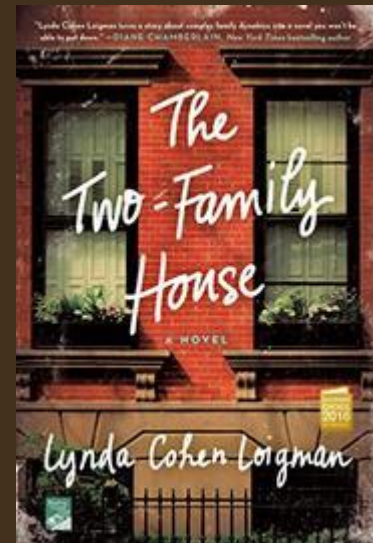
**Join us for a
