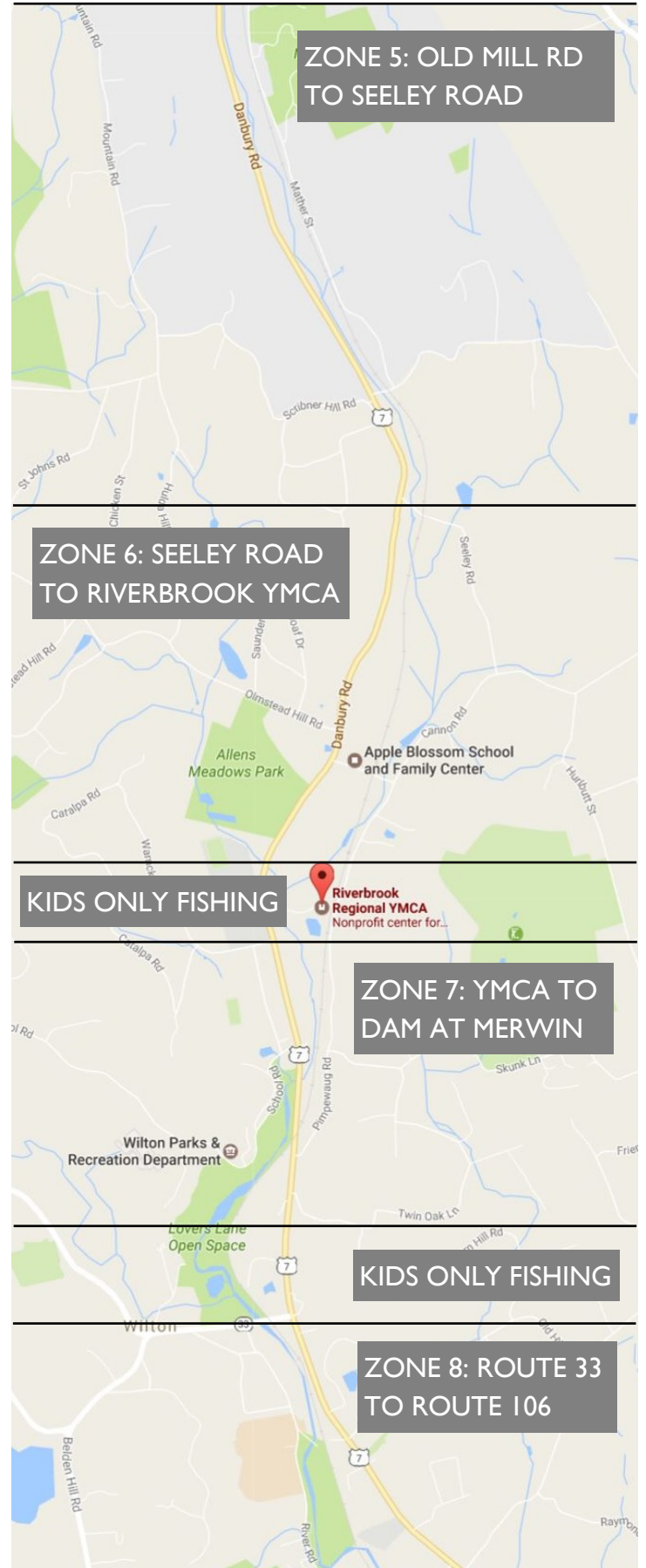


TOURNAMENT RULES & FISHING ZONES MAP

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) THIS IS ABOUT HAVING FUN & SUPPORTING CONSERVATION
- 2) RESPECT PRIVATE PROPERTY & ONLY FISH WHERE PUBLIC FISHING IS ALLOWED
- 3) CATCH & RELEASE — RELEASE ALL FISH WITHOUT ANY AVOIDABLE HARM
- 4) NO BAIT OR LURE SCENTS ARE ALLOWED
- 5) YOUTH TOURNAMENT ENTRANTS MAY USE DIFFERENT FLIES & LURES DURING THE DAY
- 6) FOR ADULTS, ONLY ONE FLY OR ONE LURE PATTERN MAY BE USED THE ENTIRE DAY
- 7) MULTIPLE VERSIONS OF THAT PATTERN MAY BE USED IF LOST WHILE FISHING
- 8) ALL VERSIONS OF THE FLY OR LURE MUST BE THE SAME COLOR SCHEME, THOUGH SIZE AND WEIGHT MAY BE CHANGED IF DESIRED
- 9) ALL FLIES & LURES MUST HAVE ONE SINGLE BARBLESS (OR CRIMPED) HOOK—NO TREBLES
- 10) ADDITIONAL WEIGHT, SUCH AS SPLIT-SHOT, MAY BE ADDED TO THE LINE FOR DEPTH
- 11) TROUT MUST BE MEASURED USING THE OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT TAPE MEASURE
- 12) MEASURE TROUT FROM TIP OF NOSE TO CENTER OF TAIL — NO PINCHING TAIL
- 13) RECORD LENGTH TO THE NEAREST 1/4 INCH IN THE OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT LOG BOOK
- 14) RECORD ZONE WHERE EACH FISH WAS CAUGHT TO HELP STUDY POPULATIONS
- 15) ALL LOG BOOKS MUST BE RETURNED BEFORE 6:00 PM TO THE YMCA CHECK-IN STATION
