ISA Certified Arborist Volunteer Service Days

Hurricane Harvey Recovery Efforts – Aransas County

The volunteer ISA Certified Arborist team you requested has done a ground-based assessment of the trees over eight (8) inches in diameter on the improved landscape of your property (Level 1 Limited Visual Tree Assessment). Please note: Not all trees may have been assessed on your property – just ones that the Arborist observed located in the improved areas of your property that may be near targets and that have obvious defects or problems. The trees with recommended treatments are marked with the following colored flagging tape:

- Red tape – Immediate Removal. This tree needs to be removed as quickly as possible
- Orange tape – Priority Removal. This tree should be removed soon (within 90 days)
- Lime tape – Immediate Pruning. Prune this tree as quickly as possible
- Yellow tape – Priority Pruning. Prune this tree soon (within 90 days)
- Blue tape – Level 2 Assessment Required. It is recommended that you have a qualified arborist come to your property and give you a more complete assessment of the tree to more appropriately gauge risk
