### Rights Granted and Reserved

FIN Press claims First North American Serial Rights only (exclusive first publication of the Work in a print book or magazine).

For a period of one (1) year from the date of the contractual agreement, the Work can be published on FIN Press's website and/or any other digital format necessary for promotion. This includes but is not limited to: the Internet, electronic download, social media, etc.

FIN Press will only sell the Work as the original print publication. No other alterations or editions will be made for sale without the creator's permission.

You will retain ownership of the Work. FIN Press only asks for credit for the first publication of the Work if another opportunity for publication arises.
