NEWLY RELOCATED VISITOR CENTRE TO OPEN MAY 15TH

[PETERBOROUGH, ON]: The newly relocated Peterborough & the Kawarthas Visitor Centre will be open to the public on Monday May 15th at 9am marking the beginning of the 2017 summer season. The new location at VentureNorth, 270 George Street North in Downtown Peterborough will be open 7 days a week from 9am -5pm, including Canada Day and Civic Holiday (Peter Robinson Day) from May 15th to October 7th.

"We are excited to get into our new downtown location, where we will be in a centralized hub that will welcome visitors travelling by foot, bicycle, boat, public transit and motor vehicle," explains Director of Tourism & Communications, Tracie Bertrand. "We look forward to providing our visitors with excellent service in person, by phone, via social media and email."

The relocation has been delayed slightly due to a change in the construction schedule. The Peterborough & the Kawarthas Visitor Centre will now open to the public on Monday May 15th at 9am. The Wolfe Street location will close its doors at 4:30pm on Wednesday May 10th.

The team at Peterborough & the Kawarthas Economic Development, including the Visitor Centre, will continue to be available by phone, email and by appointment. It is anticipated that the full Peterborough & the Kawarthas Economic Development team will be at the new location at VentureNorth on Tuesday May 23rd.
