## **Motor Vehicle renewal kiosks now operating in Dickinson and Williston**

The North Dakota Department of Transportation (NDDOT) has expanded the Motor Vehicle renewal Self Service Terminals (SST) or kiosks at two new locations in Dickinson and Williston. The kiosks are located inside the Cash Wise in Dickinson located at 1761 3<sup>rd</sup> Ave. W and Cash Wise in Williston located at 300 11<sup>th</sup> St. W. Kiosks can be found statewide at other locations in Bismarck, Fargo, Grand Forks and Minot.

The kiosk is a fully automated motor vehicle registration renewal station that will dispense license plate renewal registration cards and motor vehicle tabs on the spot. A vehicle owner can navigate through the easy touch screen (voice assistance available) and will need an invoice number from your mailed invoice OR title number and plate number. Once the payment has been submitted and the transaction is complete, the vehicle's renewed registration card and tabs are dispensed directly from the machine. The kiosk will be available during regular business hours at the participating location.

"We hope citizens find the kiosks a convenient tool allowing them to renew and print their vehicle renewals whenever they can," said Mark Nelson, NDDOT Deputy Director for Driver and Vehicle Services. "Residents can still utilize any of our branch offices, or renew online or by mail."

The kiosk allows vehicle owners to register their vehicle(s) up to 60 days prior to their expiration. Acceptable forms of payment are restricted to credit cards and pin-less Debit cards.
